

# WEST CAMPUS RESIDENTIAL INITIATIVE PHASE II

Trowbridge & Wolf Landscape Architects prepared detailed site design for Phase II of the West Campus Residential Initiative at Cornell University. The project includes walkways, gathering spaces, planting areas, and a rooftop garden for House 2 of the WCRI project. Trowbridge & Wolf designed planting for the rooftop garden that is visually interesting when viewed from the upper floors of the residence hall. Environmental benefits of the green roof include reduction of heat island effects, reduction of stormwater run-off and increased life of the roof due to reduced exposure to ultra violet rays.

The project is designed to meet LEED certification requirements. Stormwater infiltration practices, the green roof, and light fixture selection are some of the LEED certified elements. Trowbridge & Wolf also coordinated the site plan approvals and environmental review for the project.
