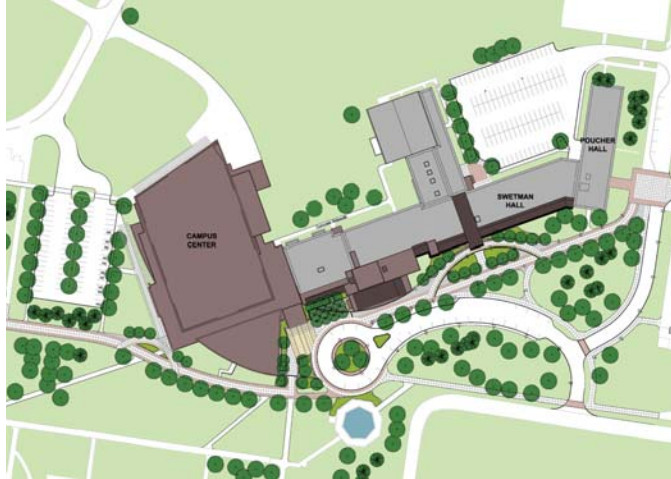


REHABILITATION OF SWETMAN & POUCHER HALLS

Swetman and Poucher Halls and the adjacent site provide the link between the historic campus and the new campus buildings that date from the 1960's and 1970's. A primary goal of the site design was to implement a first phase of a pedestrian spine that will provide a broad walkway that could span the length of the campus in the future.

Trowbridge & Wolf prepared the design and materials standards of the pedestrian walkway that includes entrance plazas and a new vehicular dropoff to serve both Swetman Hall and the adjacent Campus Center, which hosts large campus events. As part of New York State's commitment to sustainability, the project was designed to achieve as many LEED points as possible.



the pedestrian spine is a significant connector on campus
