The Corning Museum of Glass is the largest glass museum in the world. It is a beacon for culture and an international tourist destination. A renovation and addition to the original Wallace Harrison building was undertaken by Smith-Miller + Hawkinson Architects in 2000. The new glass center, theater, and enhanced programming resulted in a significant increase in visitors and a need for an orientation and information center nearby (designed by Hascup Lorenzini Architects). TWLA designed the plaza for the orientation center and the pedestrian promenade that links the center to the Museum of Glass entrance.
